I have been a relatively active member since joining in June 2020. I got a sponsor after 6 months and worked the Steps. I have chaired the Traditions and Concepts meeting so I learned a lot there. I feel that I can abide by the Al-Anon way of thinking and work well in a group. I am open to others' opinions.
